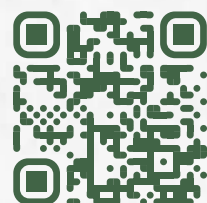

The Low-Carbon Agriculture Project – Cerrado seeks to increase the income and productivity of rural producers while reducing greenhouse gas emissions in agricultural production. It promotes the adoption of low-carbon technologies in the states of Goiás, Mato Grosso, Mato Grosso do Sul, and Minas Gerais.

PRS - Amazônia



The Low-Carbon Agriculture Project – Amazon strengthens six production chains in Amazonas, Pará, and Rondônia, supporting 30 local socio-productive organizations from cultivation and extraction to commercialization. Its goal is to increase income while promoting conservation, mitigation, and adaptation to climate change.

Sururu: Shells that transform

In the *Vergel do Lago* community in Maceió (AL), the project works mainly with local shellfish gatherers, aiming to improve quality of life, create income alternatives, and reduce the environmental impact of discarded sururu shells. These residues are transformed into innovative, value-added products, such as Cobogó Mundaú, Solar, and Fita tiles, becoming an example of circular socioeconomy.

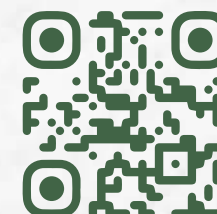
